Hebrew

05331. נִצָּח netsach, neh'-tsakh

or netsach {nay'-tsakh}; from 5329; properly, a goal, i.e. the bright object at a distance travelled towards; hence (figuratively), splendor, or (subjectively) truthfulness, or (objectively) confidence; but usually (adverbially), continually (i.e. to the most distant point of view).

05329. נָצַח natsach, naw-tsakh'

a primitive root; properly, to glitter from afar, i.e. to be eminent (as a superintendent, especially of the Temple services and its music); also (as denominative from 5331), to be permanent.

1Sa 15:29 And also the Strength <netsach> of Israel will not lie nor repent: for he is not a man, that he should repent.

1Ch 29:11 Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory <netsach>, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.

Ps 16:11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore <netsach>.

Isa 25:8 He will swallow up death in victory <netsach>; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of his people shall he take away from off all the earth: for the LORD hath spoken it.

Isa 33:20 Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle that shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever <netsach> be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.

08668. תְּשׁוּעָה t@shuw`ah, tesh-oo-aw'

or tshuah {tesh-oo-aw'}; from 7768 in the sense of 3467; rescue (literal or figurative, personal, national or spiritual).

07768. שׁוּעַ shava`, shaw-vah'

a primitive root; properly, to be free; but used only causatively and reflexively, to hail (for help, i.e. freedom from some trouble).

03467. יָשַׁע yasha`, yaw-shah'

a primitive root; properly, to be open, wide or free, i.e. (by implication) to be safe; causatively, to free or succor.

03444. יְשׁוּעָה y@shuw`ah, yesh-oo'-aw

feminine passive participle of 3467; something saved, i.e. (abstractly) deliverance; hence, aid, victory, prosperity.

03468. ישׁע yesha` , yeh'-shah

or yeshai {yay'-shah}; from 3467; liberty, deliverance, prosperity.

04190. מוֹשַׁעַהּ mowsha`ah, mo-shaw-aw'

from 3467; deliverance.

Ex 15:2 The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation <y@shuw`ah>: he is my God, and I will prepare him a habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Nu 10:9 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresses you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved <yasha`> from your enemies.

2Sa 22:3 The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation <yesha`>, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior <yasha`>; thou saves <yasha`> me from violence.

2Sa 22:47 The LORD lives; and blessed be my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my salvation <yesha`>.

1Ch 16:23 Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation <y@shuw`ah>.

1Ch 16:35 And say ye, Save <yasha`> us, O God of our salvation <yesha`>, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, and glory in thy praise.

Job 5:15 But he saves <yasha`> the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty.

Job 22:29 When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save <yasha`> the humble person.

Ps 3:8 Salvation <y@shuw`ah> belongs unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people.

Ps 12:5 For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set him in safety <yasha`> from him that puffs at him.

Ps 17:7 Shew thy marvelous lovingkindness, O thou that saves <yasha`> by thy right hand them which put their trust in thee from those that rise up against them.

Ps 98:1-3 O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvelous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory <yasha`>. The LORD hath made known his salvation <y@shuw`ah>: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen. He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation <y@shuw`ah> of our God.

Ps 109:31 For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save <yasha`> him from those that condemn his soul.

Ps 116:6 The LORD preserves the simple: I was brought low, and he helped <yasha`> me.

Ps 118:14, 15 The LORD is my strength and song and is become my salvation <y@shuw`ah>. The voice of rejoicing and salvation <y@shuw`ah> is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Ps 118:21 I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation <y@shuw`ah>.

Ps 145:19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry <shav`ah> and will save <yasha`> them.

Ps 149:4 For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation <y@shuw`ah>.

Pr 11:14 Where no counsel is, the people fall: but in the multitude of counsellors there is safety <t@shuw`ah>.

Pr 20:22 Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and he shall save <yasha`> thee.

Pr 24:6 For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety <t@shuw`ah>.

Pr 28:18 Whoso walketh uprightly shall be saved <yasha`>: but he that is perverse in his ways shall fall at once.

Isa 12:2, 3 Behold, God is my salvation <y@shuw`ah>; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation <y@shuw`ah>.

Isa 25:9 And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save <yasha`> us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation <y@shuw`ah>.

Isa 26:1 In that day shall this song be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city; salvation <y@shuw`ah> will God appoint for walls and bulwarks.

Isa 33:2 O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation <y@shuw`ah> also in the time of trouble.

Isa 33:6 And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation <y@shuw`ah>: the fear of the LORD is his treasure.

Isa 35:4 Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save <yasha`> you.

Isa 45:17 But Israel shall be saved <yasha`> in the LORD with an everlasting salvation <t@shuw`ah>: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

Isa 45:20-22 Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, ye that are escaped of the nations: they have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven image, and pray unto a god that cannot save <yasha`>. Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Savior <yasha`>; there is none beside me. Look unto me, and be ye saved <yasha`>, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.

Isa 49:6 And he said, It is a light thing that thou should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give thee for a light to the Gentiles, that thou may be my salvation <y@shuw`ah> unto the end of the earth.

Isa 49:8 Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation <y@shuw`ah> have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

Isa 49:25, 26 But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contends with thee, and I will save <yasha`> thy children. And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD am thy Savior <yasha`> and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

Isa 51:5, 6 My righteousness is near; my salvation <yasha`> is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they trust. Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but my salvation <y@shuw`ah> shall be for ever, and my righteousness shall not be abolished.

Isa 51:8 For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be forever, and my salvation <y@shuw`ah> from generation to generation.

Isa 52:7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publishes peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publishes salvation <y@shuw`ah>; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigns!

Isa 52:10 The LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation <y@shuw`ah> of our God.

Isa 56:1 Thus saith the LORD, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for my salvation <y@shuw`ah> is near to come, and my righteousness to be revealed.

Isa 59:1 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save <yasha`>; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

Isa 60:16 Thou shalt also suck the milk of the Gentiles, and shalt suck the breast of kings: and thou shalt know that I the LORD am thy Savior <yasha`> and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

Isa 60:18 Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation <y@shuw`ah>, and thy gates Praise.

Isa 62:1 For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof goes forth as brightness, and the salvation <y@shuw`ah> thereof as a lamp that burns.

Isa 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation <yasha`> cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

Jer 4:14 O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved <yasha`>. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

Jer 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved <yasha`>, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Jer 30:7 Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the time of Jacob's trouble; but he shall be saved <yasha`> out of it.

Jer 30:10, 11 Therefore fear thou not, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save <yasha`> thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make him afraid. For I am with thee, saith the LORD, to save <yasha`> thee: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered thee, yet will I not make a full end of thee: but I will correct thee in measure, and will not leave thee altogether unpunished.

Jer 31:7 For thus saith the LORD; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations: publish ye, praise ye, and say, O LORD, save <yasha`> thy people, the remnant of Israel.

Jer 33:16 In those days shall Judah be saved <yasha`>, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.

Jer 42:11 Be not afraid of the king of Babylon, of whom ye are afraid; be not afraid of him, saith the LORD: for I am with you to save <yasha`> you, and to deliver you from his hand.

Jer 46:27 But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save <yasha`> thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid.

La 3:26 It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation <t@shuw`ah> of the LORD.

Eze 34:22 Therefore will I save <yasha`> my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle.

Eze 36:29 I will also save <yasha`> you from all your uncleanness: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you.

Eze 37:23 Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save <yasha`> them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.

Ho 1:7 But I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will save <yasha`> them by the LORD their God, and will not save <yasha`> them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen.

Ho 13:4 Yet I am the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for there is no savior <yasha`> beside me.

Ob 1:21 And saviors <yasha`> shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the kingdom shall be the LORD'S.

Jon 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation <y@shuw`ah> is of the LORD.

Hab 3:18 Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation <yasha`>.

Zep 3:17 The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save <yasha`>, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.

Zep 3:19 Behold, at that time I will undo all that afflict thee: and I will save <yasha`> her that halted, and gather her that was driven out; and I will get them praise and fame in every land where they have been put to shame.

Zec 8:7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Behold, I will save <yasha`> my people from the east country, and from the west country;

Zec 8:13 And it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I save <yasha`> you, and ye shall be a blessing: fear not, but let your hands be strong.

Zec 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation <yasha`>; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Zec 9:16 And the LORD their God shall save <yasha`> them in that day as the flock of his people: for they shall be as the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon his land.

Zec 10:6 And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save <yasha`> the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them.

Greek

3534. νικος nikos, nee'-kos

from 3529; a conquest (concretely), i.e. (by implication) triumph.

3529. νικη nike, nee'-kay

apparently, a primary word; conquest (abstractly), i.e. (figuratively) the means of success.

3528. νικαω nikao, nik-ah'-o

from 3529; to subdue (literally or figuratively).

Mt 12:20 A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he sends forth judgment unto victory <nikos>.

Joh 16:33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome <nikao> the world.

Ro 3:3, 4 For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou be justified in thy sayings, and might overcome <nikao> when thou art judged.

Ro 12:21 Be <nikao> not overcome <nikao> of evil but overcome <nikao> evil with good.

1Co 15:54, 55 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory <nikos>. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory <nikos>?

1Co 15:57 But thanks be to God, which gives us the victory <nikos> through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1Jo 2:13, 14 I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome <nikao> the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father. I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and ye have overcome <nikao> the wicked one.

1Jo 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome <nikao> them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

1Jo 5:4, 5 For whatsoever is born of God overcomes <nikao> the world: and this is the victory <nike> that overcomes <nikao> the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcomes <nikao> the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

Re 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcomes <nikao> will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

Re 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcomes <nikao> shall not be hurt of the second death.

Re 2:17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcomes <nikao> will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows saving he that receives it.

Re 2:26 And he that overcomes <nikao>, and keeps my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Re 3:5 He that overcomes <nikao>, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Re 3:12 Him that overcomes <nikao> will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.

Re 3:21 To him that overcomes <nikao> will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame <nikao>, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Re 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed <nikao> to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Re 6:2 And I saw and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering <nikao>, and to conquer <nikao>.

Re 12:11 And they overcame <nikao> him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
