"Now this is the point of the story: The seed is the word of God. And those on the rock are those who with joy give hearing to the word; but having no root, they have faith for a time, and when the test comes they give up. And those which went among thorns are those who have given hearing, and go on their way, but they are overcome by cares and wealth and the pleasures of life, and they give no fruit. And those in the good earth are those who, having given ear to the word, keep it with a good and true heart, and in quiet strength give fruit." (Luke 8:11-15)

Genesis 1:27, 28

And God made man in His image, in the image of God He made him: male and female He made them. And God gave them His blessing and said to them, Be fertile and have increase, and make the earth full and be masters of it; be rulers over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the air and over every living thing moving on the earth.

Genesis 2:7

And Yahu God made man from the dust of the earth, breathing into him the breath of life: and man became a living soul.

Genesis 5:1, 2

This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day when God made man, He made him in the image of God; male and female He made them, naming them Man, and giving them His blessing on the day when they were made.

Genesis 8:22

While the earth goes on, seed time and the getting in of the grain, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night, will not come to an end.

Genesis 9:7

And now, be fertile and have increase; have offspring on the earth and become great in number.

Genesis 9:11

And I will make my agreement with you; never again will all flesh be cut off by the waters; never again will the waters come over all the earth for its destruction.

Genesis 12:3

To them who are good to you will I give blessing, and on him who does you wrong will I put my curse: and you will become a name of blessing to all the families of the earth.

(Jenesis 15:6

And he had faith in Yahu, and it was put to his account as righteousness.

Exodus 9:16

But, for this very reason, I have kept you from destruction, to make clear to you My power, and so that My Name may be honored through all the earth.

Exodus 15:2

Yah is my strength and my strong helper, He has become my salvation: He is my God and I will give Him praise; the God of my father and I will give Him glory.

Exodus 15:18

Yahu is King for ever and ever.

Exodus 33:17

And Yahu said to Moses, I will do as you say: for you have grace in My eyes, and I have knowledge of you by your name.

Numbers 6:22-27

And Yahu said to Moses, Say to Aaron and his sons, These are the words of blessing which are to be used by you in blessing the children of Israel; say to them, May Yahu send His blessing on you and keep you: May the light of Yahu's face be shining on you in grace: May Yahu's approval be resting on you and may He give you peace. So, they will put My Name on the children of Israel, and I will give them My blessing.

Numbers 11:23

And Yahu said to Moses, Has the hand of Yahu become short? Now you will see if My word comes true for you or not.

Numbers 23:19

God is not a man, to say what is false; or the son of man, that His purpose may be changed: what He has said, will He not do? And will He not give effect to the words of His mouth?

Deuteronomy 1:11

May Yahu, the God of your fathers, make you a thousand times greater in number than you are, and give you His blessing as He has said!

Deuteronomy 4:29-31

But if in those lands you are turned again to Yahu your God, searching for Him with all your heart and soul, He will not keep Himself from you. When you are in trouble and all these things have come on you, if, in the future, you are turned again to Yahu your God, and give ear to His voice: because Yahu your God is a God of mercy, He will not take away His help from you or let destruction overtake you, or be false to the agreement which He made by an oath with your fathers.

Deuteronomy 4:35

All this He let you see, so that you might be certain that Yahu is God and there is no other.

Deuteronomy 4:39

So today be certain, and keep the knowledge deep in your hearts, that Yahu is God, in heaven on high and here on earth; there is no other God.

Deuteronomy 5:10

And I will have mercy through a thousand generations on those who have love for Me and keep My laws.

Deuteronomy 6:5

And Yahu your God is to be loved with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.

Deuteronomy 7:9, 10

Be certain, then, that Yahu your God is God; Whose faith and mercy are unchanging, Who keeps His word through a thousand generations to those who have love for Him and keep His laws; rewarding His haters to their face with destruction; He will have no mercy on His hater, but will give him open punishment.

Deuteronomy 10:14

Yahu your God is ruler of heaven, of the heaven of heavens, and of the earth with everything in it.

Deuteronomy 10:17, 18

For Yahu your God is God of gods and Master of masters, the great God, strong in power and greatly to be feared, Who has no respect for the position of any man and takes no rewards: judging uprightly in the cause of the widow and of the child who has no father, and giving food and clothing in His mercy to the man from a strange country.

Deuteronomy 11:1

So have love for Yahu your God, and give Him worship, and keep His laws and His decisions and His orders at all times.

Deuteronomy 13:4

But keep on in the ways of Yahu your God, fearing Him and keeping His orders and hearing His voice, worshipping Him and being true to Him.

Deuteronomy 18:13

You are to be upright in heart before Yahu your God.

Deuteronomy 20:4

For Yahu your God goes with you, fighting for you to give you salvation from those who are against you.

Deuteronomy 30:14

But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, so that you may do it.

Deuteronomy 31:8

It is Yahu Who goes before you; He will be with you, He will not take away His help from you or give you up: so, have no fear.

Deuteronomy 32:4

He is the Rock, complete is His work; for all His ways are righteousness: a God without evil Who keeps faith, true and upright is He.

Deuteronomy 32:7

Keep in mind the days of the past, give thought to the years of generations gone by: go to your father and he will make it clear to you, to the old men and they will give you the story.

Joshua 1:8

Let this book of the law be ever on your lips and in your thoughts day and night, so that you may keep with care everything in it;

then a blessing will be on all your way, and you will do well.

Joshua 23:11

So, keep watch on yourselves, and see that you have love for Yahu your God.

1 Samuel 2:2, 3

No other is holy as Yahu, for there is no other God but You: there is no Rock like our God. Say no more words of pride; let not uncontrolled sayings come out of your mouths: for Yahu is a God of knowledge, by Him acts are judged.

1 Samuel 2:6-10

Yahu is the giver of death and life: sending men down to the underworld and lifting them up. Yahu gives wealth and takes a man's goods from him: crushing men down and again lifting them up; lifting the poor out of the dust, and him who is in need out of the lowest place, to give them their place among rulers, and for their heritage the seat of glory: for the pillars of the earth belong to Yahu and He has made them the base of the world. He will keep the feet of His holy ones, but the evil-doers will come to their end in the dark night, for by strength no man will overcome. Those who make war against Yahu will be broken; against them He will send His thunder from heaven: Yahu will be Judge of the ends of the earth; He will give strength to His king, lifting up the horn of him on whom the holy oil has been put.

1 Samuel 12:14-16

If in the fear of Yahu you are His servants, hearing His voice and not going against the orders of Yahu, but being true to Yahu your God, you and the king ruling over you, then all will be well: but if you do not give ear to the voice of Yahu, but go against His orders, then the hand of Yahu will be against you and against your king for your destruction, as it was against your fathers. Now keep where you are and see this great thing which Yahu will do before your eyes.

1 Samuel 12:22-24

For Yahu will not give His people up, because of the honor of His Name; for it has pleased Yahu to make of you a people for Himself. And as for me, never will I go against the orders of Yahu by giving up my prayers for you: but I will go on teaching you the good and right way. Only go in the fear of Yahu, and be His true servants with all your heart, keeping in mind what great things He has done for you.

25amuel 7:22

Truly you are great, O Master Yahu: there is no one like You and no other God but You, as is clear from everything which has come to our ears.

2 Samuel 22:2, 3

And he said, Yahu is my Rock, my walled town, and my Savior, even mine; my God, my Rock, in Him will I put my faith; my breastplate, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my

safe place; my Savior, Who keeps me safe from the violent man.

25amuel 22:7

In my trouble my voice went up to Yahu, and my cry to my God: my voice came to His hearing in His holy Temple, and my prayer came to His ears.

2Samuel 22:17

He sent from on high, He took me, pulling me out of great waters.

25amuel 22:21

Yahu gives me the reward of my righteousness, because my hands are clean before Him.

25amuel 22:29

For You are my light, O Yahu; and Yahu will make the dark bright for me.

25amuel 22:31,32

As for God, His way is all good: the word of Yahu is tested; He is a safe cover for all those who put their faith in Him. For Who is God but Yahu? And Who is a Rock but our God?

25amuel 22:47

Yahu is living; praise be to my Rock and let the God of my salvation be honored.

1 Kings 2:3

And keep the orders of Yahu your God, walking in His ways, keeping His laws and His orders and His rules and His words, as they are recorded in the Law of Moses; so that you may do well in all you do and wherever you go.

1 Kings 18:37

Give me an answer, O Yahu, give me an answer, so that this people may see that You are God, and that You have made their hearts come back again.

2Kings 17:39

And you are to give worship to Yahu your God; for it is He Who will give you salvation from the hands of all who are against you.

1 Chronicles 16:11, 12

Let your search be for Yahu and for His strength; let your hearts ever be turned to Him. Keep in mind the great works which He has done; His wonders, and the decisions of His mouth.

1 Chronicles 16:35

And say, Be our Savior, O God of our salvation, and let us come back, and give us salvation from the nations, so that we may give honor to Your holy Name and have glory in Your praise.

1 Chronicles 22:13

And all will go well for you, if you take care to keep the laws and the rules which Yahu gave to Moses for Israel: be strong and take heart; have no fear and do not be troubled.

1 Chronicles 29:17

And I am conscious, my God, that You are the Searcher of hearts, taking pleasure in righteousness. As for me, with an upright heart I have freely given all these things; and I have seen with joy Your people who are here to make their offerings freely to You.

2 Chronicles 6:41

Up! now, O Yahu God, come back to Your resting-place, You and the ark of Your strength: let Your priests, O Yahu God, be clothed with salvation, and let Your saints be glad in what is good.

2 Chronicles 7:14, 15

If My people, on whom My Name is named, make themselves low and come to Me in prayer, searching for Me and turning from their evil ways; then I will give ear from heaven, overlooking their sin, and will give life again to their land. Now My eyes will be open, and My ears awake to the prayers made in this place.

2 Chronicles 15:4

But when in their trouble they were turned to YaHuweh, the God of Israel, searching after Him, He let their search be rewarded.

2Chronicles 15:7

But be you strong and let not your hands be feeble, for your

work will be rewarded.

2Chronicles 16:9

For the eyes of Yahu go this way and that, through all the earth, letting it be seen that He is the strong support of those whose hearts are true to Him.

2Chronicles 19:9

And he gave them their orders, saying, You are to do your work in the fear of Yahu, in good faith and with a true heart.

2Chronicles 20:6

O Yahu, the God of our fathers, are You not God in heaven? Are You not ruler over all the kingdoms of the nations? And in Your hands are power and strength so that no one is able to keep his place against You.

Nehemiah 9:5, 6

Get up and give praise to Yahu your God for ever and ever. Praise be to Your great Name which is lifted up high over all blessing and praise. You are Yahu, even You only; You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens with all their armies, the earth and all things in it, the seas and everything in them; and You keep them from destruction: and the armies of heaven are Your worshippers.

Job 8:5-7

If you will make search for God with care, and put your request

before the Ruler of all; if you are clean and upright; then He will certainly be moved to take up your cause, and will make clear your righteousness by building up your house again. And though your start was small, your end will be very great.

Job 10:11, 12

By You I was clothed with skin and flesh, and joined together with bones and muscles. You have been kind to me, and Your grace has been with me, and Your care has kept my spirit safe.

Job 11:17

And your life will be brighter than day; though it is dark, it will become like the morning.

Job 12:12, 13

Old men have wisdom, and a long life gives knowledge. With Him there is wisdom and strength; power and knowledge are His.

Job 19:25, 26

For I know my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand as the Last upon the earth: and after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh shall | see God.

Job 22:29, 30

For God makes low those whose hearts are lifted up, but He is a Savior to the poor in spirit. He makes safe the man who is free from sin, and if your hands are clean, salvation will be yours.

Job 24:22, 23

But God by His power gives long life to the strong; he gets up again, though he has no hope of life. He takes away his fear of danger and gives him support; and His eyes are on his ways.

Job 28:28

And He said to man, Truly the fear of Yahu is wisdom, and to keep from evil is the way to knowledge.

Job 32:8

But truly it is the spirit in man, even the breath of the Ruler of all, which gives them knowledge.

Job 33:4

The spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Ruler of all gives me life.

Job 36:6,7

His eyes are ever on the upright, and He gives to the crushed their right; lifting them up to the seat of kings and making them safe for ever.

Psalms 3:8

Salvation comes from Yahu; Your blessing is on Your people.

Psalms 4:3

See how Yahu has made great His mercy for me; Yahu will give ear to my cry.

Psalms 4:8

I will take my rest on my bed in peace, because You only, Yahu, keep me safe.

Psalms 5:11, 12

But let all those who put their faith in You be glad with cries of joy at all times, and let all the lovers of Your Name be glad in You. For You, Yahu, will send a blessing on the upright man; Your grace will be round him, and You will be his strength.

Psalms 9:9, 10

Yahu will be a high tower for those who are crushed down, a high tower in times of trouble; and those who have knowledge of Your Name will put their faith in You; because You, Yahu, have ever given Your help to those who were waiting for You.

Psalms 12:5

Because of the crushing of the poor and the weeping of those in need, now will I come to his help, says Yahu; I will give him the salvation which he is desiring.

Psalms 16:11

You will make clear to me the way of life; where You are, joy is complete; in Your right hand there are pleasures for ever and ever.

Psalms 22:9

But it was You Who took care of me from the day of my birth: You gave me faith even from my mother's breasts.

Psalms 23:1-6

Yahu takes care of me as His sheep; I will not be without any good thing. He makes a resting-place for me in the green fields: He is my guide by the quiet waters. He gives new life to my soul: He is my guide in the ways of righteousness because of His Name. Yes, though I go through the valley of deep shade, I will have no fear of evil; for You are with me, Your rod and Your support are my comfort. You make ready a table for me in front of my haters: You put oil on my head; my cup is overflowing. Truly, blessing and mercy will be with me all the days of my life; and I will have a place in the house of Yahu all my days.

Psalms 25:8-10

Good and upright is Yahu: so, He will be the teacher of sinners in the way. He will be an upright guide to the poor in spirit: He will make His way clear to them. All the ways of Yahu are mercy and good faith for those who keep His agreement and His witness.

Psalms 27:13-14

I had almost given up my hope of seeing the blessing of Yahu in the land of the living. Let your hope be in Yahu: take heart and be strong; yes, let your hope be in Yahu.

Psalms 29:11

Yahu will give strength to His people; Yahu will give His people the blessing of peace.

Psalms 30:4, 5

Make songs to Yahu, O you saints of His, and give praise to His holy Name. For His wrath is only for a minute; in His grace there is life; weeping may be for a night, but joy comes in the morning.

Psalms 31:24

Put away fear and let your heart be strong, all you whose hope is in Yahu.

Psalms 33:11, 12

The purpose of Yahu is eternal, the designs of His heart go on through all the generations of man. Happy is the nation whose God is Yahu; and the people whom He has taken for His heritage.

Psalms 34:2

My soul will say great things of Yahu: the poor in spirit will have knowledge of it and be glad.

Psalms 34:6-9

This poor man's cry came before Yahu, and He gave him salvation from all his troubles. The angel of Yahu is ever watching over those who have fear of Him, to keep them safe. By

experience you will see that Yahu is good; happy is the man who has faith in Him. Keep yourselves in the fear of Yahu, all you His saints; for those who do so will have no need of anything.

Psalms 34:15

The eyes of Yahu are on the upright, and His ears are open to their cry.

Psalms 34:17-19

The cry of the upright comes before Yahu, and He takes them out of all their troubles. Yahu is near the broken-hearted; He is the Savior of those whose spirits are crushed down. Great are the troubles of the upright: but Yahu takes him safely out of them all.

Psalms 34:22

Yahu will be the Savior of the souls of His servants, and no one who has faith in Him will be put to shame.

Psalms 37:1-4

Do not be angry because of the wrongdoers, or have envy of the workers of evil. For they will quickly be cut down like grass and become dry like the green plants. Have faith in Yahu and do good; be at rest in the land and go after righteousness. So will your delight be in Yahu, and He will give you your heart's desires.

Psalms 37:5-7

Put your life in the hands of Yahu; have faith in Him and He will

do it. And He will make your righteousness be seen like the light, and your cause like the shining of the sun. Take your rest in Yahu, waiting quietly for Him; do not be angry because of the man who does well in his evil ways, and gives effect to his bad designs.

Psalms 37:8-11

Put an end to your wrath and be no longer bitter; do not give way to angry feeling which is a cause of sin. For the evil-doers will be cut off: but those who have faith in Yahu will have the earth for their heritage. For in a short time the evil-doer will be gone: you will go searching for his place, and it will not be there. But the gentle will have the earth for their heritage; they will take their delight in peace without measure.

Psalms 37:12-17

The sinner has evil designs against the upright, lifting up the voice of wrath against him. He will be laughed at by Yahu, Who sees that his day is coming. The evil-doers have taken out their swords, their bows are bent; for crushing the poor, and to put to death those who are upright in their ways. But their swords will be turned into their hearts, and their bows will be broken. The little which the good man has is better than the wealth of evil-doers. For the arms of the evil-doers will be broken: but Yahu is the support of the good.

Psalms 37:18-22

The days of the upright are numbered by Yahu, and their

heritage will be forever. They will not be shamed in the evil time, and in the days when all are in need of food they will have enough. But the wrongdoers will come to destruction, and the haters of Yahu will be like the fat of lambs, they will be burned up; they will go up in smoke, and never again be seen. The sinner takes money and does not give it back; but the upright man has mercy, and gives to others. Those who have His blessing will have the earth for their heritage; but those who are cursed by Him will be cut off.

Psalms 37:23-26

The steps of a good man are ordered by Yahu, and He takes delight in his way. Even if he has a fall he will not be without help: for the hand of Yahu is supporting him. I have been young, and now am old, but I have not seen the good man without help, or his children looking for bread. All the day he is ready to have mercy and to give; his children are a blessing.

Psalms 37:27-31

Be turned from evil and do good; and your place will be forever. For Yahu is a lover of righteousness and takes care of His saints; they will be kept safe for ever; but the seed of the evil-doers will be cut off. The upright will have the earth for their heritage and will go on living there forever. The mouth of the good man says words of wisdom; the talk of his tongue is of righteousness. The law of his God is in his heart; he will never make a false step.

Psalms 37:32-36

The sinners are watching the upright man, desiring to put him to

death. Yahu will not give him into their hands or be against him when he is judged. Be waiting for Yahu and keep His way; and you will be lifted up and have the land for your heritage: when the evil-doers are cut off, you will see it. I have seen the evil-doer in great power, covering the earth like a great tree. But he came to an end, and there was no sign of him; I made a search for him and he was not there.

Psalms 37:37-40

Give attention to the good man, and take note of the upright; because the end of that man is peace. But as for the sinners, they will be cut off together; the end of the wrongdoers is destruction. But Yahu is the Savior of the upright: He is their strength in the time of trouble. And Yahu will be their help and keep them safe: He will take them out of the hands of the evildoers, and be their Savior, because they had faith in Him.

Psalms 38:9

Yahu, all my desire is before You; my sorrow is not kept secret from You.

Psalms 38:15

In you, O Yahu, is my hope: You will give me an answer, O Yahu, my God.

Psalms 40:1-4

When I was waiting quietly for Yahu, His heart was turned to me, and He gave ear to my cry. He took me up out of a deep waste

place, out of the soft and sticky earth; He put my feet on a rock, and made my steps certain. And He put a new song in my mouth, even praise to our God; numbers have seen it with fear and put their faith in Yahu. Happy is the man who has faith in Yahu and does not give honor to the men of pride or to those who are turned away to deceit.

Psalms 40:5

O Yahu my God, great are the wonders which You have done in Your thought for us; it is not possible to put them out in order before You; when I would give an account of them, their number is greater than I may say.

Psalms 40:8

My delight is to do Your pleasure, O my God; truly, Your law is in my heart.

Psalms 40:11

Take not away Your gentle mercies from me, O Yahu; let Your mercy and Your faith keep me safe for ever.

Psalms 40:13

Be pleased, O Yahu, to take me out of danger; O Yahu, come quickly and give me help.

Psalms 40:16, 17

Let all those who are looking for You be glad and have joy in You; let the lovers of Your salvation ever say, May Yahu be great. Though I am poor and in need, Yahu has me in mind; You are my help and my Savior; let there be no waiting, O my God.

Psalms 42:5

Why are you crushed down, O my soul? And why are you troubled in me? Put your hope in God; for I will again give Him praise Who is my help and my God.

Psalms 46:1-4

God is our harbor and our strength, a very present help in trouble. For this cause we will have no fear, even though the earth is changed, and though the mountains are moved in the heart of the sea; though its waters are sounding and troubled, and though the mountains are shaking with their violent motion. There is a river whose streams make glad the resting-place of God, the holy place of the tents of the Most High.

Psalms 46:10, 11

Be at peace in the knowledge that I am God: I will be lifted up among the nations; I will be honored through all the earth. Yahu of armies is with us; the God of Jacob is our high tower.

Psalms 50:14, 15

Make an offering of praise to God; keep the agreements which you have made with the Most High; let your voice come up to Me in the day of trouble; I will be your Savior, so that you may give glory to Me.

Psalms 50:23

Whoever makes an offering of praise gives glory to Me; and to him who is upright in his ways | will make clear the salvation of God.

Psalms 51:7-10

Make me free from sin with hyssop: let me be washed whiter than snow. Make me full of joy and rapture; so that the bones which have been broken may be glad. Let Your face be turned from my wrongdoing and take away all my sins. Make a clean heart in me, O God; give me a right spirit again.

Psalms 51:14

Be my Savior from violent death, O God, the God of my salvation; and my tongue will give praise to Your righteousness.

Psalms 51:17

The offerings of God are a broken spirit; a broken and sorrowing heart, O God, You will not put from You.

Psalms 57:7, 8

My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed; I will make songs, and give praise. You are my glory; let the instruments of music be awake; I myself will be awake with the dawn.

Psalms 61:1, 2

Let my cry come to You, O God; let Your ears be open to my prayer. From the end of the earth will I send up my cry to You,

when my heart is overcome: take me to the rock which is too high for me.

Psalms 62:1, 2

My soul, put all your faith in God; for from Him comes my salvation. He only is my Rock and my salvation; He is my high tower; I will not be greatly moved.

Psalms 66:12

You let men go driving over our heads; we went through fire and through water; but You took us out into a wide place.

Psalms 68:5-6

A father to those who have no father, a judge of the widows, is God in His holy place. Those who are without friends, God puts in families; He makes free those who are in chains; but those who are turned away from Him are given a dry land.

Psalms 68:11

Yahu gives the word; great is the number of the women who make it public.

Psalms 70:5

But I am poor and in need; come to me quickly, O God; You are my help and my Savior; let there be no waiting, O Yahu.

Psalms 71:1-3

In You, O Yahu, have I put my hope; let me never be shamed.

Keep me safe in Your righteousness and come to my help; give ear to my voice and be my Savior. Be my strong Rock, the strong place of my salvation; for You are my Rock, and my safe place.

Psalms 71:19-21

Your righteousness, O God, is very high; You have done great things; O God, who is like You? You, Who have sent great and bitter troubles on me, will give me life again, lifting me up from the deep waters of the underworld. You will make me greater than before and give me comfort on every side.

Psalms 73:24, 25

Your wisdom will be my guide, and later You will put me in a place of honor. Whom have I in heaven but You? And having You I have no desire for anything on earth.

Psalms 77:1-3

I was crying to God with my voice; even to God with my voice, and He gave ear to me. In the day of my trouble, my heart was turned to Yahu: my hand was stretched out in the night without resting; my soul would not be comforted. I will keep God in memory, with sounds of grief; my thoughts are troubled, and my spirit is overcome.

Psalms 80:19

Take us back, O Yahu God of armies; let us see the shining of Your face and let us be safe.

Psalms 84:2

The passion of the desire of my soul is for the house of Yahu; my heart and my flesh are crying out for the living God.

Psalms 84:10, 11

For a day in Your house is better than a thousand. It is better to be a door-keeper in the house of my God, than to be living in the tents of sin. Yahu God is our sun and our strength: Yahu will give grace and glory: He will not keep back any good thing from those whose ways are upright.

Psalms 85:8

I will give ear to the voice of Yahu; for He will say words of peace to His people and to His saints; but let them not go back to their foolish ways.

Psalms 85:10-13

Mercy and faith have come together; righteousness and peace have given one another a kiss. Faith comes up from the earth like a plant; righteousness is looking down from heaven. YaHuweh will give what is good; and our land will give its increase. Righteousness will go before Him, making a way for His footsteps.

Psalms 86:1-4

Let Your ears be open to my voice, O Yahu, and give me an answer; for I am poor and in need. Keep my soul, for I am true to

You; O my God, give salvation to Your servant, whose hope is in You. Have mercy on me, O Yahu; for my cry goes up to You all the day. Make glad the soul of Your servant; for it is lifted up to You, O Yahu.

Psalms 90:15-17

Make us glad in reward for the days of our sorrow, and for the years in which we have seen evil. Make Your work clear to Your servants, and Your glory to their children. Let the pleasure of Yahu our God be on us: O Yahu, give strength to the work of our hands.

Psalms 91:1, 2

Happy is he whose resting-place is in the secret of Yahu, and under the shade of the wings of the Most High; who says of Yahu, He is my safe place and my tower of strength: He is my God, in Whom is my hope.

Psalms 91:14

Because he has given Me his love, I will take him out of danger: I will put him in a place of honor, because he has kept My Name in his heart.

Psalms 92:13-15

Those who are planted in the house of Yahu will come up tall and strong in His gardens. They will give fruit even when they are old; they will be fertile and full of growth; for a sign that Yahu is upright; He is my Rock, there is no deceit in Him.

Psalms 94:17-19

If Yahu had not been my helper, my soul would quickly have gone down into death. If I say, My foot is slipping; Your mercy, O Yahu, is my support. Among all my troubled thoughts, Your comforts are the delight of my soul.

Psalms 100:1-5

Make a glad sound to Yahu, all the earth. Give worship to Yahu with joy; come before Him with a song. Be certain that Yahu is God; it is He Who has made us, and we are His; we are His people, and the sheep to whom He gives food. Come into His doors with joy, and into His house with praise; give Him honor, blessing His Name. For Yahu is good, and His mercy is never ending; His faith is unchanging through all generations.

Psalms 103:11-13

For as the heaven is high over the earth, so great is His mercy to His worshippers. As far as the east Is from the west, so far has He put our sins from us. As a father has pity on his children, so Yahu has pity on His worshippers.

Psalms 105:43-45

And He took His people out with joy, the men of His selection with glad cries: and gave them the lands of the nations; and they took the work of the peoples for a heritage; so that they might keep His orders, and be true to His laws. Give praise to Yah.

Psalms 106:47

Be our Savior, O Yahu our God, and let us come back together from among the nations, so that we may give honor to Your holy Name and have glory in Your praise.

Psalms 112:5-9

All is well for the man who is kind and gives freely to others; he will make good his cause when he is judged. He will not ever be moved; the memory of the upright will be living forever. He will have no fear of evil news; his heart is fixed, for his hope is in Yahu. His heart is resting safely, he will have no fear, till he sees trouble come on his haters. He has given with open hands to the poor; his righteousness is forever; his horn will be lifted up with honor.

Psalms 116:6-9

Yahu keeps the simple; I was made low, and He was my Savior. Come back to your rest, O my soul; for Yahu has given you your reward. You have taken my soul from the power of death, keeping my eyes from weeping, and my feet from falling. I will go before Yahu in the land of the living.

Psalms 118:5

I made my prayer to Yah in my trouble: and Yah gave me an answer and put me in a wide place.

Psalms 118:14

Yah is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation.

Psalms 118:21

I will give You praise, for You have given me an answer, and have become my salvation.

Psalms 119:9

How may a young man make his way clean? By guiding it after Your word.

Psalms 119:11

I have kept Your sayings secretly in my heart, so that I might do no sin against You.

Psalms 119:50-52

This is my comfort in my trouble; that Your sayings have given me life. The men of pride have made great sport of me; but I have not been turned from Your law. I have kept the memory of Your decisions from times past, O Yahu; and they have been my comfort.

Psalms 119:71,72

It is good for me to have been through trouble; so that I might come to the knowledge of Your rules. The law of Your mouth is better to me than thousands of gold and silver.

Psalms 119:75-77

I have seen, O Yahu, that Your decisions are right, and that in unchanging faith You have sent trouble on me. Let Your mercy now be my comfort, as You have said to Your servant. Let Your

gentle mercies come to me, so that I may have life; for Your law is my delight.

Psalms 119:92, 93

If Your law had not been my delight, my troubles would have put an end to me. I will ever keep Your orders in mind; for in them I have life.

Psalms 119:107-109 | I am greatly troubled, O Yahu, give me life in keeping with Your word. Take, O Yahu, the free offerings of my mouth, and give me knowledge of Your decisions. My soul is ever in danger; but I still keep the memory of Your law.

Psalms 119:116, 117

Be my support as You have said and give me life; let not my hope be turned to shame. Let me not be moved, and I will be safe, and ever take delight in Your rules.

Psalms 119:143-149

Pain and trouble have overcome me: but Your teachings are my delight. The righteousness of Your unchanging word is eternal; give me wisdom so that I may have life. I have made my prayer with all my heart; give answer to me, O Yahu: I will keep Your rules. My cry has gone up to You; take me out of trouble, and I will be guided by Your unchanging word. Before the sun is up, my cry for help comes to Your ear; my hope is in Your words. In the night watches I am awake, so that I may give thought to Your saying. Let my voice come to You, in Your mercy; O Yahu, by

your decisions give me life.

Psalms 119:153-156

O see my trouble, and be my Savior; for I keep Your law in my mind, undertake my cause, and come to my help, give me life, as You have said. Salvation is far from evil-doers; for they have made no search for Your rules. Great is the number of Your mercies, O Yahu; give me life in keeping with Your decisions.

Psalms 119:169, 170

Let my cry come before You, O Yahu; give me wisdom in keeping with Your word. Let my prayer come before You; take me out of trouble, as You have said.

Psalms 119:173-175

Let Your hand be near for my help; for I have given my heart to Your orders. All my desire has been for Your salvation, O Yahu; and Your law is my delight. Give life to my soul so that it may give You praise; and let Your decisions be my support.

Psalms 121:1-3

My eyes are lifted up to the hills: O where will my help come from? Your help comes from Yahu, Who made heaven and earth. May He not let your foot be moved: no need of sleep has He Who keeps you.

Psalms121:7, 8

Yahu will keep you safe from all evil; He will take care of your

soul. Yahu will keep watch over your going out and your coming in, from this time and forever.

Psalms 124:7, 8

Our soul has gone free like a bird out of the net of those who would take her: the net is broken, and we are free. Our help is in the Name of Yahu, the Maker of heaven and earth.

Psalms 126:5, 6

Those who put in seed with weeping will get in the grain with cries of joy. Though a man may go out weeping, taking his vessel of seed with him; he will come again in joy, with the corded stems of grain in his arms.

Psalms 127:1, 2

If Yahu is not helping the builders, then the building of a house is to no purpose: if Yahu does not keep the town, the watchman keeps his watch for nothing. It is of no use for you to get up early, and to go late to your rest, with the bread of sorrow for your food; for Yahu gives to His loved ones in sleep.

Psalms 128:1, 2

Happy is the worshipper of Yahu, who is walking in His ways. You will have the fruit of the work of your hands: happy will you be, and all will be well for you.

Psalms 139:7-10

Where may I go from Your spirit? How may I go in flight from

You? If I go up to heaven, You are there: or if I make my bed in the underworld, You are there. If I take the wings of the morning and go to the farthest parts of the sea; even there will I be guided by Your hand, and Your right hand will keep me.

Psalms 139:13, 14

My flesh was made by You, and my parts joined together in my mother's body. I will give You praise, for I am strangely and delicately formed; Your works are great wonders, and of this my soul is fully conscious.

Psalms 140:12, 13

I am certain that Yahu will take care of the cause of the poor, and of the rights of those who are troubled. Truly, the upright will give praise to Your Name: the holy will have a place in Your house.

Psalms 143:8

Let the story of Your mercy come to me in the morning, for my hope is in You: give me knowledge of the way in which I am to go; for my soul is lifted up to You.

Psalms 143:10, 11

Give me teaching so that I may do Your pleasure; for You are my God: let Your good Spirit be my guide into the land of righteousness. Give me life, O Yahu, because of Your Name; in Your righteousness take my soul out of trouble.

Psalms 144:12-15

Our sons are like tall young plants; and our daughters like the shining stones of a king's house; our store-houses are full of all good things; and our sheep give birth to thousands and ten thousands in our fields. Our oxen are well weighted down; our cows give birth safely; there is no going out and there is no cry of sorrow in our open places. Happy is the nation whose ways are so ordered: yes, happy is the nation whose God is Yahu.

Proverbs 3:5-10

Put all your hope in Yahu, not looking to your reason for support. In all your ways give ear to Him, and He will make straight your footsteps. Put no high value on your wisdom: let the fear of Yahu be before you and keep yourself from evil: this will give strength to your flesh, and new life to your bones. Give honor to Yahu with your wealth, and with the first-fruits of all your increase: so, your store-houses will be full of grain, and your vessels overflowing with new wine.

Proverbs 9:10, 11

The fear of Yahu is the start of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One gives a wise mind. For by Me your days will be increased, and the years of your life will be long.

Proverbs 11:14

When there is no helping suggestion the people will have a fall, but with a number of wise guides they will be safe.

Proverbs 12:25

Care in the heart of a man makes it weighted down, but a good word makes it glad.

Proverbs 13:12

Hope put off is a weariness to the heart; but when what is desired comes, it is a tree of life.

Proverbs 13:14

The teaching of the wise is a fountain of life, turning men away from the nets of death.

Proverbs 14:4

Where there are no oxen, their food-place is clean; but much increase comes through the strength of the ox.

Proverbs 14:10

No one has knowledge of a man's grief but himself; and a strange person has no part in his joy.

Proverbs 14:14

He whose heart is turned away will have the reward of his ways in full measure; but a good man will have the reward of his doings.

Proverbs 14:21

He who has no respect for his neighbor is a sinner, but he who has pity for the poor is happy.

Proverbs 14:27

The fear of Yahu is a fountain of life, by which one may be turned from the nets of death.

Proverbs 14:31

He who is hard on the poor puts shame on his Maker; but he who has mercy on those who are in need gives Him honor.

Proverbs 15:3,4

The eyes of Yahu are in every place, keeping watch on the evil and the good. A comforting tongue is a tree of life, but a twisted tongue is a crushing of the spirit.

Proverbs 15:13

A glad heart makes a shining face, but by the sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

Proverbs 15:15-17

All the days of the troubled are evil; but he whose heart is glad has an unending feast. Better is a little with the fear of Yahu, than great wealth together with trouble. Better is a simple meal where love is, than a fat ox and hate with it.

Proverbs 15:22

Where there are no wise suggestions, purposes come to nothing; but by a number of wise guides they are made certain.

Proverbs 15:24

Acting wisely is the way of life, guiding a man away from the underworld.

Proverbs 15:30, 31

The light of the eyes is a joy to the heart, and good news makes the bones fat. The man whose ear is open to the teaching of life will have his place among the wise.

Proverbs 16:3

Put your works into the hands of Yahu, and your purposes will be made certain.

Proverbs 16:6, 7

By mercy and good faith evil-doing is taken away: and by the fear of Yahu men are turned away from evil. When a man's ways are pleasing to Yahu, he makes even his haters be at peace with him.

Proverbs 16:9

A man may make designs for his way, but Yahu is the guide of his steps.

Proverbs 16:16

How much better it is to get wisdom than gold! And to get knowledge is more to be desired than silver.

Proverbs 16:20, 21

He who gives attention to the law of right will get good; and

whoever puts his faith in Yahu is happy. The wise-hearted will be named men of good sense: and by pleasing words learning is increased.

Proverbs 16:23, 24

The heart of the wise man is the teacher of his mouth, and gives increased learning to his lips. Pleasing words are like honey, sweet to the soul and new life to the bones.

Proverbs 16:26

The desire of the working man is working for him, for his need of food is driving him on.

Proverbs 17:17

A friend is loving at all times and becomes a brother in times of trouble.

Proverbs 17:27, 28

He who has knowledge says little: and he who has a calm spirit is a man of good sense. Even the foolish man, when he keeps quiet, is taken to be wise: when his lips are shut he is credited with good sense.

Proverbs 18:10

The Name of Yahu is a strong tower: the upright man running into it is safe.

Proverbs 19:8

He who gets wisdom has love for his soul: he who keeps good sense will get what is truly good.

Proverbs 20:7

An upright man goes on in his righteousness: happy are his children after him!

Proverbs 21:5

The purposes of the man of industry have their outcome only in wealth; but one who is over-quick in acting will only come to be in need.

Proverbs 21:23

He who keeps watch over his mouth and his tongue keeps his soul from troubles.

Proverbs 22:1

A good name is more to be desired than great wealth, and to be respected is better than silver and gold.

Proverbs 23:17, 18

Have no envy of sinners in your heart but keep in the fear of Yahu all through the day; for without doubt there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off.

Proverbs 27:9

Oil and perfume make glad the heart, and the wise suggestion of

a friend is sweet to the soul.

Ecclesiastes 2:24

There is nothing better for a man than taking meat and drink, and having delight in his work. This again I saw was from the hand of God.

Ecclesiastes 3:12

I am certain that there is nothing better for a man than to be glad, and to do good while life is in him.

Ecclesiastes 3:22

So I saw that there is nothing better than for a man to have joy in his work—because that is his reward. Who will make him see what will come after him?

Ecclesiastes 8:12

Though a sinner does evil a hundred times and his life is long, I am certain that it will be well for those who go in fear of God and are in fear before Him.

Ecclesiastes 8:15

So, I gave praise to joy, because there is nothing better for a man to do under the sun than to take meat and drink and be happy; for that will be with him in his work all the days of his life which God gives him under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 12:13

This is the last word. All has been said. Have fear of God and keep His laws; because this is right for every man.

Song of Solomon 8:6,7

Put me as a sign on your heart, as a sign on your arm; love is strong as death, and wrath bitter as the underworld: its coals are coals of fire; violent are its flames. Much water may not put out love, or the deep waters overcome it: if a man would give all the substance of his house for love, it would be judged a price not great enough.

saíah 1:17

Take pleasure in well-doing; let your ways be upright, keep down the cruel, give a right decision for the child who has no father, see to the cause of the widow.

saiah 2:5

O family of Jacob, come, and let us go in the light of Yahu.

Isaiah 9:2

The people who went in the dark have seen a great light, and for those who were living in the land of the deepest night, the light is shining.

saiah 9:6

For to us a Child has come, to us a Son is given; and the government has been placed in His hands; and He has been

named Wise Guide, Strong God, Father forever, Prince of Peace.

Isaíah 11:1, 2

And there will come a rod out of the broken tree of Jesse, and a branch out of His roots will give fruit. And the spirit of Yahu will be resting on Him, the spirit of wisdom and good sense, the spirit of wise guiding and strength, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yahu.

saíah 11:4

But He will do right in the cause of the poor and give wise decisions for those in the land who are in need; and the rod of His mouth will come down on the cruel, and with the breath of His lips He will put an end to the evil-doer.

saíah 12:2

See, God is my salvation; I will have faith in Yahu, without fear: for Yah Yahu is my strength and song; and He has become my salvation.

saiah 16:3

Give wise directions, make a decision; let Your shade be as night in full day: keep safe those who are in flight; do not give up the wandering ones.

saiah 25:1

O Yahu, You are my God; I will give praise to You, I will give

honor to Your Name; for You have done great acts of power; Your purposes in the past have been made true and certain in effect.

Isaiah 25:4

For You have been a strong place for the poor and the crushed in their trouble, a safe place from the storm, a shade from the heat, when the wrath of the cruel ones is like a winter storm.

Isaíah 25:8, 9

He has put an end to death for ever; and the Master Yahu will take away all weeping; and He will put an end to the shame of His people in all the earth: for Yahu has said it. And in that day, it will be said, See, this is our God; we have been waiting for Him, and He will be our Savior: this is Yahu in Whom is our hope; we will be glad and have delight in His salvation.

Isaiah 26:3,4

The man whose heart is unmoved You will keep in peace, because his hope is in You. Let your hope be in Yahu for ever: for Yah Yahu is an unchanging Rock.

saiah 26:7, 8

The way of the good man is straight; the road of the upright is made smooth by You. We have been waiting for You, O Yahu; the desire of our soul is for the memory of Your Name.

saíah 26:19

Your dead will come back; their dead bodies will come to life again. Those in the dust, awaking from their sleep, will send out a song; for Your dew is a dew of light, and the earth will give birth to the shades.

saiah 26:20

Come, my people, into your secret places, and let your doors be shut: keep yourself safe for a short time, till His wrath is over.

saiah 29:18, 19

And in that day those whose ears are stopped will be hearing the words of the book; and the eyes of the blind will see through the mist and the dark. And the poor will have their joy in Yahu increased, and those in need will be glad in the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 29:23, 24

But when they, the children of Jacob, see the work of My hands among them, they will give honor to My Name; yes, they will give honor to the Holy One of Jacob, and go in fear of the God of Israel. Those whose hearts were turned away from Him will get knowledge, and those who made an outcry against Him will give attention to His teaching.

Isaiah 30:17, 18

A thousand will go in fear before one; even before five you will go in flight: till you are like a pillar by itself on the top of a mountain,

and like a flag on a hill. For this cause Yahu will be waiting, so that He may be kind to you; and He will be lifted up, so that He may have mercy on you; for Yahu is a God of righteousness: there is a blessing on all whose hope is in Him.

saiah 41:10

Have no fear, for I am with you; do not be looking about in trouble, for I am your God; I will give you strength, yes, I will be your helper; yes, My true right hand will be your support.

saíah 41:13

For I, Yahu your God, have taken your right hand in Mine, saying to you, Have no fear; I will be Your helper.

saiah 43:2

When you go through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they will not go over you: when you go through the fire, you will not be burned; and the flame will have no power over you.

saiah 45:21, 22

Give the word, put forward your cause, let us have a discussion together: who has given news of this in the past? Who made it clear in early times? Did not I, Yahu? And there is no God but Me; a true God and a Savior; there is no other. Let your hearts be turned to Me, so that you may have salvation, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is no other.

saiah 46:3, 4

Give ear to me, O family of Jacob, and all the rest of the people of Israel, who have been supported by Me from their birth, and have been My care from their earliest days: Even when you are old I will be the same, and when you are grey-haired I will take care of you: I will still be responsible for what I made; yes, I will take you and keep you safe.

Isaiah 49:13

Let your voice be loud in song, O heavens; and be glad, O earth; make sounds of joy, O mountains, for Yahu has given comfort to His people, and will have mercy on His crushed ones.

saíah 51:15

For I am Yahu your God, Who makes the sea calm when its waves are thundering: Yahu of armies is His Name.

saiah 52:7

How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him who comes with good news, who gives word of peace, saying that salvation is near; who says to Zion, Your God is ruling!

saiah 54:4, 5

Have no fear; for you will not be shamed or without hope: you will not be put to shame, for the shame of your earlier days will go out of your memory, and you will no longer keep in mind the sorrows of your widowed years. For your Maker is your husband; Yahu of armies is His Name: and the Holy One of Israel is He Who

takes up your cause; He will be named the God of all the earth.

saíah 54:10

For the mountains may be taken away, and the hills be moved out of their places, but My love will not be taken from you, or My agreement of peace broken, says Yahu, Who has had mercy on you.

saiah 54:17

No instrument of war which is formed against you will be of any use; and every tongue which says evil against you will be judged false. This is the heritage of the servants of Yahu, and their righteousness comes from Me, says Yahu.

saiah 55:3

Give ear, and come to Me, take note with care, so that your souls may have life: and I will make an eternal agreement with you, even the certain mercies of David.

saiah 55:6-11

Make search for Yahu while He is there, make prayer to Him while He is near: Let the sinner give up his way, and the evil-doer his purpose: and let him come back to Yahu, and He will have mercy on him; and to our God, for there is full forgiveness with Him. For My thoughts are not your thoughts, or your ways My ways, says Yahu. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts. For as the rain comes down, and the snow from

heaven, and does not go back again, but gives water to the earth, and makes it fertile, giving seed to the planter, and bread for food; so will My word be which goes out of My mouth: it will not come back to Me with nothing done, but it will give effect to My purpose, and do that for which I have sent it.

Isaiah 56:1, 2

Yahu says, Let your way of life be upright, and let your behavior be rightly ordered: for My salvation is near, and My righteousness will quickly be seen. Happy is the man who does this, and the son of man whose behavior is so ordered; who keeps the Sabbath holy, and his hand from doing any evil.

Isaiah 56:6, 7

And as for those from a strange country, who are joined to Yahu, to give worship to Him and honor to His Name, to be His servants, even everyone who keeps the Sabbath holy, and keeps His agreement with Me: I will make them come to My holy mountain, and will give them joy in My house of prayer; I will take pleasure in the burned offerings which they make on My altar: for My house will be named a house of prayer for all peoples.

|saíah *57*:1*5*

For this is the word of Him Who is high and lifted up, Whose resting-place is eternal, Whose Name is Holy: My resting-place is in the high and holy place, and with him who is crushed and poor in spirit, to give life to the spirit of the poor, and to make strong the heart of the crushed.

saiah 58:6-8

Is not this the holy day for which I have given orders: to let loose those who have wrongly been made prisoners, to undo the bands of the yoke, and to let the crushed go free, and every yoke be broken? Is it not to give your bread to those in need, and to let the poor who have no resting-place come into your house? To put a robe on the unclothed one when you see him, and not to keep your eyes shut for fear of seeing his flesh? Then will light be shining on you like the morning, and your wounds will quickly be well: and your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of Yahu will come after you.

Isaiah 60:1, 2

Up! Let your face be bright, for your light has come, and the glory of Yahu is shining on you. For truly, the earth will be dark, and the peoples veiled in blackest night; but Yahu will be shining on you, and His glory will be seen among you.

saiah 61:1-3

The spirit of Yahu is on me, because I am marked out by Him to give good news to the poor; He has sent me to make the broken-hearted well, to say that the prisoners will be made free, and that those in chains will see the light again; to give knowledge that the year of the good pleasure of Yahu has come, and the day of punishment from our God; to give comfort to all who are sad; to give them a fair head-dress in place of dust, the oil of joy in place of the clothing of grief, praise in place of sorrow; so that they may

be named trees of righteousness, the planting of Yahu, and so that He may have glory.

Jeremiah 3:22-23

Come back, you children who have been turned away, and I will take away your desire for wandering. See, we have come to You, for You are Yahu our God. Truly, the hills, and the noise of an army on the mountains, are a false hope: truly, in Yahu our God is the salvation of Israel.

Jeremiah 6:16

This is what Yahu has said: Take your place looking out on the ways; make search for the old roads, saying, Where is the good way? And go in it that you may have rest for your souls.

Jeremiah 9:23, 24

This is the word of Yahu: Let not the wise man take pride in his wisdom, or the strong man in his strength, or the man of wealth in his wealth: but if any man has pride, let it be in this, that he has the wisdom to have knowledge of Me, that I am Yahu, working mercy, giving true decisions, and doing righteousness in the earth: for in these things I have delight, says Yahu.

Jeremiah 10:23, 24

O Yahu, I am conscious that the way of a man is not in himself: man has no power of guiding his steps. O Yahu, put me right, but with wise purpose; not in Your wrath, or You will make me small.

Jeremiah 17:7, 8

A blessing is on the man who puts his faith in Yahu, and whose hope is Yahu. For he will be like a tree planted by the waters, pushing out its roots by the stream; he will have no fear when the heat comes, but his leaf will be green; in a dry year he will have no care, and will go on giving fruit.

Jeremiah 20:13

Make melody to Yahu, give praise to Yahu: for He has made the soul of the poor man free from the hands of the evil-doers.

Jeremiah 22:3

This is what Yahu has said: Do what is right, judging uprightly, and make free from the hands of the cruel one him whose goods have been violently taken away: do no wrong and be not violent to the man from a strange country and the child without a father and the widow, and let not those who have done no wrong be put to death in this place.

Lamentations 3:21-26

This | keep in mind, and because of this | have hope. It is through the love of Yahu that we have not come to destruction, because His mercies have no limit. They are new every morning; great is Your good faith. I said to myself, Yahu is my heritage; and because of this | will have hope in Him. Yahu is good to those who are waiting for Him, to the soul which is looking for Him. It is good to go on hoping and quietly waiting for the salvation of Yahu.

Lamentations 3:55~58

I was making prayer to Your Name, O Yahu, out of the lowest prison. My voice came to You; let not Your ear be shut to my breathing, to my cry. You came near in the day when I made my prayer to You: You said, Have no fear. O Yahu, You have taken up the cause of my soul, You have made my life safe.

Ezekiel 11:19, 20

And I will give them a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in them; and I will take the heart of stone out of their flesh and give them a heart of flesh: so that they may be guided by My rules and keep My orders and do them: and they will be to Me a people, and I will be to them a God.

Fzekiel 20:11-12

And I gave them My rules and made clear to them My orders, which, if a man keeps them, will be life to him. And further, I gave them My Sabbaths, to be a sign between Me and them, so that it might be clear that I, Who make them holy, am Yahu.

Ezekiel 20:19-20

I am Yahu your God; be guided by My rules and keep My orders and do them: And keep My Sabbaths holy; and they will be a sign between Me and you so that it may be clear to you that I am Yahu your God.

Ezekiel 34:22-26

I will make My flock safe, and they will no longer be taken away, and I will be judge between sheep and sheep. And I will put over them one keeper, and He will give them food, even My servant David; He will give them food and be their keeper. And I Yahu will be their God and My servant David their ruler; I Yahu have said it. And I will make with them an agreement of peace, and will put an end to evil beasts through all the land: and they will be living safely in the waste land, sleeping in the woods. And I will give the rain at the right time, and I will make the shower come down at the right time; there will be showers of blessing.

Ezekiel 37:12-14

For this cause be a prophet to them, and say, This is what Yahu has said: See, I am opening the resting-places of your dead, and I will make you come up out of your resting-places, O My people; and I will take you into the land of Israel. And you will be certain that I am YaHuweh by My opening the resting-places of your dead and making you come up out of your resting-places, O My people. And I will put My spirit in you, so that you may come to life, and I will give you a rest in your land: and you will be certain that I Yahu have said it and have done it, says Yahu.

Ezekiel 38:23

And I will make My Name great and make Myself holy, and I will make Myself clear to a number of nations; and they will be certain that I am Yahu.

Daniel 2:20-22

And Daniel said in answer, May the Name of God be praised for ever and ever: for wisdom and strength are His: by Him times and years are changed: by Him kings are taken away and kings are lifted up: He gives wisdom to the wise, and knowledge to those whose minds are awake: He is the unveiler of deep and secret things: He has knowledge of what is in the dark, and the light has its living-place with Him.

Daniel 7:27

And the kingdom and the authority and the power of the kingdoms under all the heaven will be given to the people of the saints of the Most High: His kingdom is an eternal kingdom, and all powers will be His servants and do His pleasure.

Daniel 11:32 And those who do evil against the agreement will be turned to sin by his fair words: but the people who have knowledge of their God will be strong and do well.

Daniel 12:1-3

And at that time Michael will take up his place, the great angel, who is the supporter of the children of Your people: and there will be a time of trouble, such as there never was from the time there was a nation even till that same time: and at that time Your people will be kept safe, everyone who is recorded in the book. And a number of those who are sleeping in the dust of the earth will come out of their sleep, some to eternal life and some to eternal shame. And those who are wise will be shining like the light of the

outstretched sky; and those by whom numbers have been turned to righteousness will be like the stars for ever and ever.

Joel 2:12, 13

But even now, says Yahu, come back to me with all your heart, keeping from food, with weeping and with sorrow: let your hearts be broken, and not your clothing, and come back to Yahu your God: for He is full of grace and pity, slow to be angry and great in mercy, ready to be turned from His purpose of punishment.

Amos 4:13

For see, He Who gave form to the mountains and made the wind, giving knowledge of His purpose to man, Who makes the morning dark, and is walking on the high places of the earth: Yahu, the God of armies, is His Name.

Amos 5:14

Go after good and not evil, so that life may be yours: and so Yahu, the God of armies, will be with you, as you say.

Jonah 2:7

When my soul in me was overcome, I kept the memory of Yahu: and my prayer came in to You, into Your holy Temple.

Micah 6:8

He has made clear to you, O man, what is good; and what is desired from you by Yahu; only doing what is right, and loving mercy, and walking without pride before your God.

Micah 7:7

But as for me, I am looking to Yahu; I am waiting for the God of my salvation: the ears of my God will be open to me.

Micah 7:18-19

Who is a God like You, offering forgiveness for evil-doing and overlooking the sins of the rest of His heritage? He does not keep His wrath forever, because His delight is in mercy. He will again have pity on us; He will put our sins under His feet: and You will send all our sins down into the heart of the sea.

Nahum 1:7

Yahu is good, a strong place in the day of trouble; and He has knowledge of those who take Him for their safe cover.

Nahum 1:15

See on the mountains the feet of him who comes with good news, giving word of peace! Keep your feasts, O Judah, give effect to your oaths: for the good-for-nothing man will never again go through you; he is completely cut off.

Habakkuk 3:17, 18

For though the fig-tree has no flowers, and there is no fruit on the vine, and work on the olive comes to nothing, and the fields give no food; and the flock is cut off from its resting-place, and there is no herd in the cattle-house: Still, I will be glad in Yahu, my joy will be in the God of my salvation.

Zephaniah 2:3

Make search for Yahu, all you quiet ones of the earth, who have done what is right in His eyes; make search for righteousness and a quiet heart: it may be that you will be safely covered in the day of the wrath of Yahu.

Zephaniah 3:19

See, at that time | will put an end to all who have been troubling you: | will give salvation to her whose steps are uncertain, and get together her who has been sent in flight; and | will make them a cause of praise and an honored name in all the earth, when | let their fate be changed.

Malachí 3:1

See, I am sending My servant, and He will make ready the way before Me; and Yahu, Whom you are looking for, will suddenly come to His Temple; and the Angel of the agreement, in Whom you have delight, see, He is coming, says Yahu of armies.

Matthew 5:5

Happy are the gentle: for the earth will be their heritage.

Matthew 7:11, 12

If you, then, being evil, are able to give good things to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good things to those who make requests to Him? All those things, then, which you would have men do to you, even so do you to them:

because this is the law and the prophets.

Matthew 10:32

To everyone, then, who gives witness to Me before men, I will give witness before my Father in heaven.

Matthew 11:28-30

Come to Me, all you who are troubled and weighted down with care, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke on you and become like Me, for I am gentle and without pride, and you will have rest for your souls; for My yoke is good, and the weight I take up is not hard.

Matthew 22:36-40

Master, which is the chief rule in the law? And He said to him, Have love for Yahu your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest rule. And a second like it is this, Have love for your neighbor as for yourself. On these two rules all the law and the prophets are based.

Matthew 26:41

Keep watch with prayer, so that you may not be put to the test: the spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is feeble.

Mark 1:14, 15

Yahusha came into Galilee, preaching the good news of God, and saying, The time has come, and the kingdom of God is near:

let your hearts be turned from sin and have faith in the good news.

Mark 2:27, 28

And He said to them, The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath; so that the Son of man is Master even of the Sabbath.

Mark 10:45

For truly the Son of man did not come to have servants, but to be a servant, and to give His life for the salvation of men.

Mark 12:29-31

And one of the scribes came, and hearing their argument together, and seeing that He had given them a good answer, put the question to Him, Which law is the first of all? Yahusha said in answer, The first is, Give ear, O Israel: Yahu our God is one Yah; and you are to have love for Yahu your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength. The second is this, Have love for your neighbor as for yourself. There is no other law greater than these.

Luke 1:37

For there is nothing which God is not able to do.

Luke 1:45

Happy will she be who had faith that the things which Yahu has said to her will be done.

Luke 4:18, 19

The Spirit of Yahu is on Me, because I am marked out by Him to give good news to the poor; He has sent Me to make well those who are broken-hearted; to say that the prisoners will be let go, and the blind will see, and to make the wounded free from their chains, to give knowledge that the year of the good pleasure of Yahu is come.

Luke 6:20-23

Happy are you who are poor: for the kingdom of God is yours. Happy are you who are in need of food now: for you will be made full. Happy are you who are weeping now; for you will be glad. Happy are you, when men have hate for you, and put you away from among them and say angry words to you, turning away in disgust at your name, because of the Son of man. Be glad in that day, and be lifted up for joy, for your reward in heaven will be great: for their fathers did these same things to the prophets.

Luke 6:27-30

But I say to you who give ear to Me, Have love for those who are against you, do good to those who have hate for you, give blessing to those who give you curses, say prayers for those who are cruel to you. If a man gives you a blow on one side of your face, then let the other side be turned to him; from him who takes away your coat, do not keep back your robe. Give to everyone who comes with a request, and if a man takes away your property, make no attempt to get it back again.

Luke 6:31-36

Do to others as you would have them do to you. If you have love for those who have love for you, what credit is it to you? For even sinners have love for those who have love for them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is it to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you let those have the use of your money, from whom you are hoping to get it back, what credit is it to you? Even sinners do so to sinners, hoping to get back as much as they gave. But be loving to those who are against you and do them good, and give them your money, not giving up hope, and your reward will be great and you will be the sons of the Most High: for He is kind to evil men, and to those who have hard hearts. Be full of pity, even as your Father is full of pity.

Luke 6:37, 38

Be not judges of others, and you will not be judged: do not give punishment to others, and you will not get punishment yourselves: make others free, and you will be made free: give, and it will be given to you; good measure, crushed down, full and running over, they will give to you. For in the same measure as you give, it will be given to you again.

Luke 9:23, 24

And He said to them all, If any man has a desire to come after Me, let him give up all, and take up his cross every day, and come after Me. For whoever has a desire to keep his life will have it taken from him, but whoever gives up his life because of Me, will keep it.

Luke 11:9, 10

And I say to you, Make requests, and they will be answered; what you are searching for, you will get; when you give the sign, the door will be open to you. For to everyone who makes a request, it will be given; and he who is searching will get his desire; and to him who gives the sign, the door will be open.

Luke 12:6, 7

Are not five sparrows given in exchange for two farthings? And God has every one of them in mind. But even the hairs of your head are numbered. Have no fear: you are of more value than a flock of sparrows.

Luke 19:10

For the Son of man came to make search for those who are wandering from the way, and to be their Savior.

Luke 24:44-47

And He said to them, These are the words which I said to you when I was still with you, how it was necessary for all the things which are in the writings of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms about Me, to be put into effect. Then He made the holy Writings clear to their minds. And He said to them, So it is in the Writings that the Anointed would undergo death, and come back to life again on the third day; and that teaching about a change of heart and forgiveness of sins is to be given to Jerusalem first and to all nations in His Name.

John 1:12-14

To all those who did so take Him, however, He gave the right of becoming children of God—that is, to those who had faith in His Name: whose birth was from God and not from blood, or from an impulse of the flesh and desire of man. And so the Word became flesh and took a place among us for a time; and we saw His glory—such glory as is given to an only son by his father—saw it to be true and full of grace.

John 3:5-7

Yahusha said in answer, Truly, I say to you, If a birth of a man is not from water and from the Spirit, it is not possible for him to go into the kingdom of God. That which has birth from the flesh is flesh, and that which has birth from the Spirit is spirit. Do not be surprised that I say to you, It is necessary for you to have a second birth.

John 3:14-17

As the snake was lifted up by Moses in the waste land, even so it is necessary for the Son of man to be lifted up: so that whoever has faith may have in Him eternal life. For God had such love for the world that He gave His only Son, so that whoever has faith in Him may not come to destruction but have eternal life. God did not send His Son into the world to be judge of the world; He sent Him so that the world might have salvation through Him.

John 5:24

Truly I say to you, The man whose ears are open to My word and who has faith in Him Who sent Me, has eternal life; he will not be judged, but has come from death into life.

John 5:39

You make search in the holy Writings, in the belief that through them you get eternal life; and it is those Writings which give witness about Me.

John 6:35

And this was the answer of Yahusha: I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me will never be in need of food, and he who has faith in Me will never be in need of drink.

John 6:37

Whatever the Father gives to Me will come to Me; and I will not send away anyone who comes to Me.

John 6:40

This, I say, is the pleasure of My Father, that everyone who sees the Son and has faith in Him may have eternal life: and I will take him up on the last day.

John 6:44

No man is able to come to Me if the Father Who sent Me does not give him the desire to come: and I will take him up from the dead on the last day.

John 8:12

Then again Yahusha said to them, I am the light of the world; he who comes with Me will not be walking in the dark but will have the light of life.

John 8:36

If then the Son makes you free, you will be truly free.

John 10:9

I am the door: if any man goes in through Me he will have salvation, and will go in and go out, and will get food.

John 10:27, 28

My sheep give ear to My voice, and I have knowledge of them, and they come after Me: and I give them eternal life; they will never come to destruction, and no one will ever take them out of My hand.

John 11:25, 26

Yahusha said to her, I am Myself that day and that life; he who has faith in Me will have life even if he is dead; and no one who is living and has faith in Me will ever see death. Is this your faith?

John 11:40

Yahusha said to her, Did I not say to you that if you had faith you would see the glory of God?

John 12:26

If any man is My servant, let him come after Me; and where I am, there will My servant be. If any man becomes My servant, My Father will give him honor.

John 12:32

And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will make all men come to Me.

John 12:46

I have come as a light into the world, so that no one who has faith in Me will go on living in the dark.

John 13:34, 35

I give you a new law: Have love one for another; even as I have had love for you, so are you to have love one for another. By this it will be clear to all men that you are My disciples, if you have love one for another.

John 14:1-6

Let not your heart be troubled: have faith in God and have faith in Me. In my Father's house are rooms enough; if it was not so, would I have said that I am going to make ready a place for you? And if I go and make ready a place for you, I will come back again and will take you to be with Me, so that you may be where I am. And you all have knowledge of where I am going, and of the way to it. Thomas said, Master, we have no knowledge of where You are going; how may we have knowledge of the way? Yahusha said

to him, I am the true and living way: no one comes to the Father but by Me.

John 14:27

May peace be with you; My peace I give to you: I give it not as the world gives. Let not your heart be troubled; let it be without fear.

John 15:3-8

You are clean, even now, through the teaching which I have given you. Be in Me at all times as I am in you. As the branch is not able to give fruit of itself, if it is not still on the vine, so you are not able to do so if you are not in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches: he who is in Me at all times as I am in him, gives much fruit, because without Me you are able to do nothing. If a man does not keep himself in Me, he becomes dead and is cut off like a dry branch; such branches are taken up and put in the fire and burned. If you are in Me at all times, and My words are in you, then anything for which you make a request will be done for you. Here is the glory of My Father, in that you give much fruit and so are My true disciples.

John 15:9-13

Even as the Father has given Me His love, so I have given My love to you: be ever in My love. If you keep My laws, you will be ever in My love, even as I have kept the laws of My Father and am ever in His love. I have said these things to you so that I may have joy in you and so that your joy may be complete. This is the law I

give you: Have love one for another, even as I have love for you. Greater love has no man than this, that a man gives up his life for his friends.

John 16:33

I have said all these things to you so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have trouble: but take heart! I have overcome the world.

John 20:30, 31

A number of other signs Yahusha did before His disciples which are not recorded in this book: but these are recorded, so that you may have faith that Yahusha is the Anointed, the Son of God, and so that, having this faith you may have life in His Name.

Acts 2:38

And Peter said, Let your hearts be changed, every one of you, and have immersion in the Name of Yahusha the Anointed, for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will have the Holy Spirit given to you.

Acts 4:12

And in no other is there salvation: for there is no other name under heaven, given among men, through which we may have salvation.

Acts 10:34, 35

Then Peter said, Truly, I see clearly that God is no respecter of

persons: but in every nation, the man who has fear of Him and does righteousness is pleasing to Him.

Acts 10:43

To Him all the prophets give witness, that through His Name everyone who has faith in Him will have forgiveness of sins.

Acts 16:31

And they said, Have faith in the Master Yahusha, and you and your family will have salvation.

Acts 24:14-16

But this I will say openly to you, that I do give worship to the God of our fathers after that Way, which to them is not the true religion: but I have belief in all the things which are in the law and in the books of the prophets: hoping in God for that which they themselves are looking for, that there will be a coming back from the dead for upright men and wrongdoers. And in this, I do my best at all times to have no reason for shame before God or men.

Romans 5:1-5

For which reason, because we have righteousness through faith, let us be at peace with God through our Master Yahusha the Anointed; through Whom, in the same way, we have been able by faith to come to this grace in which we now are; and let us have joy in hope of the glory of God. And not only so but let us have joy in our troubles: in the knowledge that trouble gives us the power of waiting; and waiting gives experience; and experience, hope:

and hope does not put to shame; because our hearts are full of the love of God through the Holy Spirit Which is given to us.

Romans 5:20, 21

And the law came in addition, to make wrongdoing worse; but where there was much sin, there was much more grace: that, as sin had power in death, so grace might have power through righteousness to eternal life through Yahusha the Anointed our Master.

Romans 6:4

We have been placed with Him among the dead through immersion into death: so that as the Anointed came again from the dead by the glory of the Father, we, in the same way, might be living in new life.

Romans 6:23

For the reward of sin is death; but what God freely gives is eternal life in Yahusha the Anointed our Master.

Romans 8:11

But if the Spirit of Him Who made Yahusha come again from the dead is in you, He Who made the Anointed Yahusha come again from the dead will in the same way, through His Spirit Which is in you, give life to your bodies which now are under the power of death.

Romans 8:28

And we are conscious that all things are working together for good to those who have love for God and have been marked out by His purpose.

Romans 8:31, 32

What may we say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He Who did not keep back His only Son, but gave Him up for us all, will He not with Him freely give us all things?

Romans 8:38, 39

For I am certain that not death, or life, or angels, or rulers, or things present, or things to come, or powers, or things on high, or things under the earth, or anything which is made, will be able to come between us and the love of God which is in the Anointed Yahusha our Master.

Romans 10:9, 10

Because, if you say with your mouth that Yahusha is Master and have faith in your heart that God has made Him come back from the dead, you will have salvation: for with the heart man has faith to get righteousness, and with the mouth he says that Yahusha is Master to get salvation.

Romans 12:1, 2

For this reason, I make request to you, brothers, by the mercies of God, that you will give your bodies as a living offering, holy, pleasing to God, which is the worship, it is right for you to give

Him. And let not your behavior be like that of this world, but be changed and made new in mind, so that by experience you may have knowledge of the good and pleasing and complete purpose of God.

Romans 12:10-13

Be kind to one another with brotherly love, putting others before yourselves in honor; be not slow in your work, but be quick in spirit, as the servants of the Master; being glad in hope, quiet in trouble, at all times given to prayer, giving to the needs of the saints, ready to take people into your houses.

Romans 12:21

Do not let evil overcome you but overcome evil by good.

Romans 16:25-27

Now to Him Who is able to make you strong in agreement with the good news which I gave you and the preaching of Yahusha the Anointed, in the light of the revelation of that secret which has been kept through times eternal, but is now made clear; and by the writings of the prophets, by the order of the eternal God, the knowledge of it has been given to all the nations, so that they may come under the rule of the faith; to the only wise God, through Yahusha the Anointed, be the glory forever.

1 Corinthians 1:18

For the word of the cross seems foolish to those who are on the way to destruction; but to us who are on the way to salvation it is

the power of God.

1 Corinthians 6:12

I am free to do all things; but not all things are wise. I am free to do all things; but I will not let myself come under the power of any.

1 Corinthians 10:13

You have been put to no test but such as is common to man: and God is true, Who will not let any test come on you which you are not able to undergo; but He will make with the test a way out of it, so that you may be able to go through it.

1 Corinthians 10:23

We are free to do all things, but there are things which it is not wise to do. We are free to do all things, but not all things are for the common good.

2Corinthians 1:12

For our glory is in this, in the knowledge which we have that our way of life in the world, and most of all in relation to you, has been holy and true in the eyes of God; not in the wisdom of the flesh, but in the grace of God.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7

Love is never tired of waiting; love is kind; love has no envy; love has no high opinion of itself, love has no pride. The ways of love are ever fair, it takes no thought for itself; it is not quickly made angry, it takes no account of evil; it takes no pleasure in

wrongdoing but has joy in what is true; love has the power of undergoing all things, having faith in all things, hoping all things.

1 Corinthians 15:51-58

See, I am giving you the revelation of a secret: we will not all come to the sleep of death, but we will all be changed. In a second, in the shutting of an eye, at the sound of the last horn: for at that sound the dead will come again, free for ever from the power of death, and we will be changed. For this body which comes to destruction will be made free from the power of death, and the man who is under the power of death will put on eternal life. But when this has taken place, then that which was said in the Writings will come true, Death is overcome by life. O death, where is your power? O death, where are your pains? The pain of death is sin; and the power of sin is the law: but praise be to God Who gives us strength to overcome through our Master Yahusha the Anointed. For this cause, my dear brothers, be strong in purpose and unmoved, ever giving yourselves to the work of the Master, because you are certain that your work is not without effect in the Master.

1 Corinthians 16:13, 14

Be on the watch, unmoved in the faith, and be strong like men. Let all you do be done in love.

2 Corinthians 1:3-7

Praise be to the God and Father of our Master Yahusha the Anointed, the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort;

Who gives us comfort in all our troubles, so that we may be able to give comfort to others who are in trouble, through the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. For as we undergo more of the pain which the Anointed underwent, so through the Anointed does our comfort become greater. But if we are troubled, it is for your comfort and salvation; or if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which takes effect through your quiet undergoing of the same troubles which we undergo: and our hope for you is certain; in the knowledge that as you take part in the troubles, so you will take part in the comfort.

2Corinthians 1:21, 22

Now He who makes our faith strong together with you, in the Anointed, and has given us of His grace, is God; and it is He Who has put His stamp on us, even the Spirit, as the sign in our hearts of the coming glory.

2 Corinthians 3:17

Now Yahu is the Spirit: and where the Spirit of Yahu is, there the heart is free.

2Corinthians 5:17

If any man is in the Anointed, he is in a new world: the old things have come to an end; they have truly become new.

Galatians 2:20

I have been put to death on the cross with the Anointed; still I am living; no longer I, but the Anointed is living in me; and that life

which I now am living in the flesh I am living by faith, the faith of the Son of God, Who in love for me, gave Himself up for me.

Galatians 5:13, 14

Because you, brothers, were marked out to be free; only do not make use of your free condition to give the flesh its chance, but through love be servants one to another. For all the law is made complete in one word, even in this, Have love for your neighbor as for yourself.

Ephesians 2:4-9

But God, being full of mercy, through the great love which He had for us, even when we were dead through our sins, gave us life together with the Anointed (by grace you have salvation), so that we came back from death with Him, and are seated with Him in the heavens, in the Anointed Yahusha; that in the time to come He might make clear the full wealth of His grace in His mercy to us in the Anointed Yahusha: because by grace you have salvation through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is given by God: not by works, so that no man may take glory to himself.

Ephesians 3:20, 21

Now to Him Who is able to do in full measure more than all our desires or thoughts, through the power which is working in us, to Him be the glory in the assembly and in the Anointed Yahusha to all generations for ever and ever. So be it.

Ephesians 4:31, 32

Let all bitter, sharp and angry feeling, and noise, and evil words, be put away from you, with all unkind acts; and be kind to one another, full of pity, having forgiveness for one another, even as God in the Anointed had forgiveness for you.

Ephesians 5:2

And be living in love, even as the Anointed had love for you, and gave Himself up for us, an offering to God for a perfume of a sweet smell.

Ephesians 6:10-13

Lastly, be strong in the Master, and in the strength of His power. Take up of God the instruments of war, so that you may be able to keep your position against all the deceits of the evil one. For our fight is not against flesh and blood, but against authorities and powers, against the world-rulers of this dark night, against the spirits of evil in the heavens. For this reason, take up all the arms of God, so that you may be able to be strong in the evil day, and, having done all, to keep your place.

Philippians 1:9-11

And my prayer is that you may be increased more and more in knowledge and experience; so that you may give your approval to the best things; that you may be true and without wrongdoing till the day of the Anointed; being full of the fruits of righteousness, which are through Yahusha the Anointed, to the glory and praise of God.

Philippians 1:19-21

For I am conscious that this will be for my salvation, through your prayer and the giving out of the stored wealth of the Spirit of Yahusha the Anointed, in the measure of my strong hope and belief that in nothing will I be put to shame, but that without fear, as at all times, so now will the Anointed have glory in my body, by life or by death. For to me life is the Anointed and death is profit.

Philippians 2:5-11

Let this mind be in you which was in the Anointed Yahusha, to Whom, though Himself in the form of God, it did not seem that to take for oneself was to be like God; but He made Himself as nothing, taking the form of a servant, being made like men; and being seen in form as a man, He took the lowest place, and let Himself be put to death, even the death of the cross. For this reason God has put Him in the highest place and has given to Him the Name which is greater than every name; so that at the Name of Yahusha every knee may be bent, of those in heaven and those on earth and those in the underworld, and that every tongue may give witness that Yahusha the Anointed is Master, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 4:4-7

Be glad in Yahu at all times: again I say, Be glad. Let your gentle behavior be clear to all men. The Master is near. Have no cares; but in everything with prayer and praise put your requests before God. And the peace of God, which is deeper than all knowledge, will keep your hearts and minds in the Anointed Yahusha.

Philippians 4:8

For the rest, my brothers, whatever things are true, whatever things have honor, whatever things are upright, whatever things are holy, whatever things are beautiful, whatever things are of value, if there is any virtue and if there is any praise, give thought to these things.

Philippians 4:13

I am able to do all things through Him Who gives me strength.

Colossians 3:1, 2

If then you have a new life with the Anointed, give your attention to the things of heaven, where the Anointed is seated at the right hand of God. Keep your mind on the higher things, not on the things of earth.

Colossians 3:12-14

As saints of God, then, holy and dearly loved, let your behavior be marked by pity and mercy, kind feeling, a low opinion of yourselves, gentle ways, and a power of undergoing all things; being gentle to one another and having forgiveness for one another, if anyone has done wrong to his brother, even as the Anointed had forgiveness for you: and more than all, have love; the only way in which you may be completely joined together.

Colossians 3:15-17

Let the word of the Anointed be in you in all wealth of wisdom; teaching and helping one another with songs of praise and holy words, making melody to God with grace in your hearts. And whatever you do, in word or in act, do all in the name of the Master Yahusha, giving praise to God the Father through Him.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

But it is our desire, brothers, that you may be certain about those who are sleeping; so that you may have no need for sorrow, as others have who are without hope. For if we have faith that Yahusha underwent death and came back again, even so those who are sleeping will come again with Him by the power of God. For this we say to you by the word of the Master, that we who are still living at the coming of the Master, will not go before those who are sleeping. Because the Master Himself will come down from heaven with a word of authority, with the voice of the chief angel, with the sound of a horn: and the dead in the Anointed will come to life first; then we who are still living will be taken up together with them into the clouds to see the Master in the air: and so will we be forever with the Master. So then, give comfort to one another with these words.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-13

For the purpose of God for us is not wrath, but salvation through our Master Yahusha the Anointed, Who was put to death for us, so that, awake or sleeping, we may have a part in His life. So then, go on comforting and building up one another, as you have been doing. But we make this request to you, my brothers: give attention to those who are working among you, who are over you in the Master to keep order among you; and have a high opinion of them in love because of their work.

1 Thessalonians 5:14-18

Be at peace among yourselves. And our desire is that you will keep control over those whose lives are not well ordered, giving comfort to the feeble-hearted, supporting those with little strength, and putting up with much from all. Let no one give evil for evil; but ever go after what is good, for one another and for all. Have joy at all times. Keep on with your prayers. In everything give praise: for this is the purpose of God in the Anointed Yahusha for you.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-23

Do not put out the light of the Spirit; do not make little of the words of the prophets; let all things be tested; keep to what is good; keep from every form of evil. And may the God of peace Himself make you holy in every way; and may your spirit and soul and body be free from all sin at the coming of our Master Yahusha the Anointed.

2Thessalonians 2:16, 17

Now our Master Yahusha the Anointed Himself, and God our Father Who had love for us and has given us eternal comfort and good hope through grace, give you comfort and strength in every good work and word.

2 Thessalonians 3:16

Now the Master of peace Himself give you peace at all times and in every way. May the Master be with you all.

1 Timothy 2:1, 2

My desire is, first of all, that you will make requests and prayers and give praise for all men; for kings and all those in authority; so that we may have a calm and quiet life in all fear of God and serious behavior.

2 Timothy 3:16, 17

Every holy Writing which comes from God is of profit for teaching, for training, for guiding, for education in righteousness: so that the man of God may be complete, trained and made ready for every good work.

2 Timothy 4:7, 8

I have made a good fight, I have come to the end of my journey, I have kept the faith: from now on, the crown of righteousness is made ready for me, which the Master, the upright Judge, will give to me at that day: and not only to me, but to all those who have had love for His revelation.

2 Timothy 4:18

The Master will keep me safe from every evil work and will give me salvation in His kingdom in heaven: to Whom be glory for ever and

ever. So be it.

Titus 2:11-14

For the grace of God has come, giving salvation to all men, training us so that, turning away from evil and the desires of this world, we may be living wisely and uprightly in the knowledge of God in this present life; looking for the glad hope, the revelation of the glory of our great God and Savior Yahusha the Anointed; Who gave Himself for us, so that He might make us free from all wrongdoing, and make for Himself a people clean in heart and on fire with good works.

Titus 3:4-7

But when the mercy of God our Savior, and His love to man was seen, not by works of righteousness which we did ourselves, but in the measure of His mercy, He gave us salvation, through the washing of the new birth and the giving of new life in the Holy Spirit, Which He gave us freely through Yahusha the Anointed our Savior; so that, having been given righteousness through grace, we might have a part in the heritage, the hope of eternal life.

Hebrews 3:12~15

My brothers, take care that there is not by chance in any one of you an evil heart without belief, turning away from the living God: but give comfort to one another every day as long as it is still Today; so that no one among you may be made hard by the deceit of sin: for if we keep the substance of the faith which we

had at the start, even till the end, we have a part with the Anointed; as it is said, Today if you will let His voice come to your ears, be not hard of heart, as when you made Him angry.

Hebrews 4:14-16

Having then a great high priest, Who has made His way through the heavens, even Yahusha the Son of God, let us be strong in our faith. For we have not a high priest who is not able to be touched by the feelings of our feeble flesh; but we have One Who has been tested in all points as we ourselves are tested, but without sin. Then let us come near to the seat of grace without fear, so that mercy may be given to us, and we may get grace for our help in time of need.

Hebrews 6:9, 10

But, my loved ones, though we say this, we are certain that you have better things in you, things which go with salvation; for God is true, and will not put away from Him the memory of your work and of your love for His Name, in the help which you gave and still give to the saints.

Hebrews 10:19-25

So then, my brothers, being able to go into the holy place without fear, because of the blood of Yahusha, by the new and living way which He made open for us through the veil, that is to say, His flesh; and having a great priest over the house of God, let us go in with true hearts, in certain faith, having our hearts made free from the sense of sin and our bodies washed with clean water: let us

keep the witness of our hope strong and unshaking, for He is true Who has given His word: and let us be moving one another at all times to love and good works; not giving up our meetings, as is the way of some, but keeping one another strong in faith; and all the more because you see the day coming near.

Hebrews 11:1-3

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, and the sign that the things not seen are true. For by it our fathers had the approval of God. By faith it is clear to us that the order of events was fixed by the word of God, so that what is seen has not been made from things which only seem to be.

Hebrews 12:11-13

At the time all punishment seems to be pain and not joy: but after, those who have been trained by it get from it the peace-giving fruit of righteousness. For this cause let the hands which are hanging down be lifted up, and let the feeble knees be made strong, and make straight roads for your feet, so that the feeble may not be turned out of the way, but may be made strong.

Hebrews 13:20, 21

Now may the God of peace, Who made that great Keeper of His flock, even our Master Yahusha, come back from the dead through the blood of the eternal agreement, make you full of every good work and ready to do all His desires, working in us whatever is pleasing in His eyes through Yahusha the Anointed; and may the glory be given to Him for ever and ever. So be it.

James 1:2-5

Let it be all joy to you, my brothers, when you undergo tests of every sort; because you have the knowledge that the testing of your faith gives you the power of going on in hope; but let this power have its full effect, so that you may be made complete, needing nothing. But if any man among you is without wisdom, let him make his request to God, Who gives freely to all without an unkind word, and it will be given to him.

James 1:12

There is a blessing on the man who undergoes testing; because, if he has the approval of God, he will be given the crown of life, which the Master has said He will give to those who have love for Him.

James 1:17

Every good and true thing is given to us from heaven, coming from the Father of lights, with Whom there is no change, or any shade made by turning.

James 3:17, 18

But the wisdom which is from heaven is first holy, then gentle, readily giving way in argument, full of peace and mercy and good works, not doubting, not seeming other than it is. And the fruit of righteousness is planted in peace for those who make peace.

James 4:6-7

But He gives more grace. So that the Writings say, God is against the men of pride, but He gives grace to those who make themselves low before Him. For this cause be ruled by God; but make war on the evil one and he will be put to flight before you.

James 4:9-10

Be troubled, with sorrow and weeping; let your laughing be turned to sorrow and your joy to grief. Make yourselves low in the eyes of the Master and you will be lifted up by Him.

James 5:7, 8

Go on waiting calmly, my brothers, till the coming of the Master, like the farmer waiting for the good fruit of the earth till the early and late rains have come. Be as calm in your waiting; let your hearts be strong: because the coming of the Master is near.

James 5:13-16

Is anyone among you in trouble? Let him say prayers. Is anyone glad? Let him make a song of praise. Is anyone among you ill? Let him send for the rulers of the assembly; and let them say prayers over him, putting oil on him in the Name of the Master. And by the prayer of faith the man who is ill will be made well, and he will be lifted up by the Master, and for any sin which he has done he will have forgiveness. So then, make a statement of your sins to one another, and say prayers for one another so that you may be made well. The prayer of a good man is full of power in its working.

1 Peter 1:6-9

You have cause for great joy in this, though it may have been necessary for you to be troubled for a little time, being tested in all sorts of ways, so that the true metal of your faith, being of much greater value than gold (which, though it comes to an end, is tested by fire), may come to light in praise and glory and honor, at the revelation of Yahusha the Anointed: to Whom your love is given, though you have not seen Him; and the faith which you have in Him, though you do not see Him now, gives you joy greater than words and full of glory: for so you have the true end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.

1 Peter 2:21-25

This is the purpose of God for you: because Yahusha Himself underwent punishment for you, giving you an example, so that you might go in His footsteps: Who did no evil, and there was no deceit in His mouth: to sharp words He gave no sharp answer; when He was undergoing pain, no angry word came from His lips; but He put Himself into the hands of the Judge of righteousness: He took our sins on Himself, giving His body to be nailed on the tree, so that we, being dead to sin, might have a new life in righteousness, and by His wounds we have been made well. Because, like sheep, you had gone out of the way; but now you have come back to Him Who keeps watch over your souls.

1 Peter 3:8, 9

Last of all, see that you are all in agreement; feeling for one

another, loving one another like brothers, full of pity, without pride: not giving back evil for evil, or curse for curse, but in place of cursing, blessing; because this is the purpose of God for you that you may have a heritage of blessing.

1 Peter 4:12-14

Dear brothers, do not be surprised, as if it was something strange, if your faith is tested as by fire: but be glad that you are given a part in the pains of the Anointed; so that at the revelation of His glory you may have great joy. If men say evil things of you because of the Name of the Anointed, happy are you; for the Spirit of glory and of God is resting on you.

1 Peter 5:8-11

Be serious and keep watch; the evil one, who is against you, goes about like a lion with open mouth in search of food; do not give way to him but be strong in your faith, in the knowledge that your brothers who are in the world undergo the same troubles. And after you have undergone pain for a little time, the God of all grace Who has given you a part in His eternal glory through the Anointed Yahusha, will Himself give you strength and support, and make you complete in every good thing; His is the power forever. So be it.

2Peter 3:9

Yahusha is not slow in keeping His word, as He seems to some, but He is waiting in mercy for you, not desiring the destruction of any, but that all may be turned from their evil ways.

1 John 2:17

And the world and its desires is coming to an end: but he who does the pleasure of God is living forever.

1 John 3:2

My loved ones, now we are children of God, and at present it is not clear what we are to be. We are certain that at His revelation we will be like Him; for we will see Him as He is.

1 John 4:4

You are of God, my little children, and you have overcome them because He Who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:7

My loved ones let us have love for one another: because love is of God, and everyone who has love is a child of God and has knowledge of God.

1 John 4:15-17

Everyone who says openly that Yahusha is the Son of God, has God in him and is in God. And we have seen and had faith in the love which God has for us. God is love, and everyone who has love is in God, and God is in him. In this way love is made complete in us, so that we may be without fear on the day of judging, because as He is, so are we in this world.

1 John 5:4

Anything which comes from God is able to overcome the world: and the power by which we have overcome the world is our faith.

Jude 1:20, 21

But you, my loved ones, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, and making prayers in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for life eternal through the mercy of our Master Yahusha the Anointed.

Jude 1:24, 25

Now to Him Who is able to keep you from falling, and to give you a place in His glory, free from all evil, with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Yahusha the Anointed our Master, let us give glory and honor and authority and power, before all time and now and forever. So be it.

Revelation 2:7

He who has ears, let him give ear to what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes I will give of the fruit of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God.

Revelation 2:11

He who has ears, let him give ear to what the Spirit says to the assemblies. He who overcomes will not come under the power of the second death.

Revelation 2:17

He who has ears, let him give ear to what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes I will give of the secret manna, and I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name, of which no one has knowledge but he to whom it is given.

Revelation 2:26-28

He who overcomes, and keeps My works to the end, to him I will give rule over the nations, and he will be ruling them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of the potter they will be broken, even as I have power from My Father: and I will give him the morning star.

Revelation 3:5

He who overcomes will be dressed in white, and I will not take his name from the book of life, and I will give witness to his name before My Father, and before His angels.

Revelation 3:12

Him who overcomes I will make a pillar in the house of My God, and he will go out no more: and I will put on him the Name of My God, and the name of the town of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new Name.

Revelation 3:20

See, I am waiting at the door and giving the sign; if My voice comes to any man's ears and he makes the door open, I will come in to him, and will take food with him and he with Me.

Revelation 3:21

To him who overcomes I will give a place with Me on My high seat, even as I overcame, and am seated with My Father on His high seat.

Revelation 20:6

Happy and holy is he who has a part in this first coming: over these the second death has no authority, but they will be priests of God and of the Anointed and will be ruling with Him a thousand years.

Revelation 21:3,4

And there came to my ears a great voice out of the high seat, saying, See, the Tent of God is with men, and He will make His living-place with them, and they will be His people, and God Himself will be with them, and be their God. And He will put an end to all their weeping; and there will be no more death, or sorrow, or crying, or pain; for the first things have come to an end.

Revelation 21:6, 7

And He said to me, It is done. I am the First and the Last, the start and the end. I will freely give of the fountain of the water of life to him who is in need. He who overcomes will have these things for his heritage; and I will be his God, and he will be My son.

Revelation 22:12, 13

See, I come quickly; and My reward is with Me, to give to every man the outcome of his works. I am the First and the Last, the start and the end.

Revelation 22:16, 17

I, Yahusha, have sent My angel to give witness to you of these things in the assemblies. I am the root and the offspring of David, the bright and morning Star. And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him who gives ear, say, Come. And let him who is in need come; and let everyone desiring it take of the water of life freely.

Revelation 22:20, 21

He who gives witness to these things says, Truly, I come quickly. Even so come, Master Yahusha. The grace of the Master Yahusha be with the saints. So be it.

A Testimony

In the beginning, Elohim created the heavens and the Earth. He caused the Earth to produce all living species. Yahu Elohim made man out of the earth and He made woman from the man. He placed the couple in a special area with all that they would need for life. Yahu gave these people commandments so that they could keep a good environment. Yahu had given man a freedom of choice, and so, obeying the commandments would be a way that they could show their love for Him. To show His grace, Yahu allowed His enemy, Satan, to deceive Adam and Chawwah. Satan was successful and so the depravity of the human species became instinctive behavior.

Yahu Elohim had to punish the humans for their disobedience. He removed them from their garden so that they would not live forever. They had lost their innocence and so they had to wear clothing. Clean animals were to be killed and burnt as a sacrifice for the wrong deeds of the people. But, with all of the punishments, Yahu made a promise to Adam and Chawwah. He told them that one day a human would be born Who would deliver them from the powers of Satan and the eternal punishments for misbehavior.

Hundreds of years later, Yahu Elohim chose a man by the name of Abram to be the father of a special race of humans. Yahu changed his name to Abraham and promised that a descendant of his would bless the entire world. The people of the Race of Abraham became known as Yisra'el. Not only would the Messiah come from these people, but the Oracles of Elohim were also placed into their trust. These Scriptures teach that the Savior would be the human revelation of Yahu.

At the appointed time, Yahusha was born as the Savior of Yisra'el. His physical nature is human without the instinct to misbehave. He is Elohim by all definitions, and so He could not violate His own purity and righteousness. The main assignment for Yahusha would be to die as the final sacrifice for the wrong committed since the beginning of time and for eternity. Yahusha grew up, becoming a teacher and miracle worker, proclaiming life and liberty for those who would believe in Him. The religious authorities convinced the government to have Him executed. He was buried, and on the third day, He rose from the dead. The resurrection of Yahusha proves that He is the Anointed One of Master Yahusha the Anointed invites everyone in the world, to come to Him and accept His salvation, deliverance, and hope.

There are seven Principles of Salvation and Deliverance that are taught throughout the Scriptures.

- 1. Fear Yahu.
 - He will punish people breaking His laws.
- 2. Humble yourself.
 - People need deliverance and protection.
- 3. Believe in Yahusha.

He will pardon people trusting Him.

4. Call on Yahusha.

Speak what you believe and need.

5. Expect Yahusha to save.

He loves you and wants to be your Savior.

6. Be Immersed into Yahusha.

Enter into His covenant relationship.

7. Follow the Commandments.

Blessings come through obedience.

Prayers found in Scripture

Let Your Name be my salvation, O God; let my cause be judged by your strength. (Psalms 54:1)

In you, O Yahu, have I put my hope; let me never be shamed. Keep me safe in Your righteousness and come to my help; give ear to my voice and be my savior. Be my strong Rock, the strong place of my salvation; for You are my Rock, and my safe place. (Psalms 71:1-3)

Let Your hand be on (Yahusha) the Man of Your right hand, on the Son of man whom You made strong for Yourself. So, will we not be turned back from You; keep us in life, and we will give praise to Your Name. Take us back, O Yahu, God of armies; let us see the shining of Your face and let us be safe. (Psalms 80:17-19)

Let Your ears be open to my voice, O Yahu, and give me an answer; for I am poor and in need.

Keep my soul, for I am true to You; O my God, give salvation to Your servant, whose hope is in You. (Psalms 86:1-2)

Though our sins give witness against us, do something, O Yahu, for the honor of Your Name: for again and again we have been turned away from You, we have done evil against You. (Jeremiah 14:7)

Make me well, O Yahu, and I will be well; be my savior, and I will be safe: for You are my hope. (Jeremiah 17:14)

Confessions

(I believe that) whoever makes his prayer to Yahu will have salvation. (Acts 2:21)

(I believe) that in the Name of Yahusha the Anointed of Nazareth, (Who was) put to death on the cross, Whom God gave back from the dead, . . . And in no other is there salvation: for there is no other name under heaven, given among men, through which we may have salvation. (Acts 4:10-12)

(I confess with my) mouth that Yahusha is Master, and (I) have faith in (my) heart that God has made Him come back from the dead. (Romans 10:9-13) Amen.
